•Founded in November 2004 by Nikolai Tsvetkov, the president of the URALSIB Financial Corporation and his family members, and legally registered as a non-profit organization, Victoria Children Foundation (VCF) works to improve the quality of life of orphans and abandoned children in Russia.

•More than 300 orphan homes from 46 regions of Russian Federation participated in VCF programs

•VCF Annual beneficent budget is about \$ 7 mln.

Program approach

We work to bring back genuine parents' love and care into disadvantaged families; we support children in their physical, spiritual and intellectual development and help them to obtain emotional balance, self-confidence and trust into people and future.

VISION BY YEAR 2015:

•Guided by national traditions and international best practices in charity and volunteerism, VCF works together with partner organizations to ensure good quality services are available for disadvantaged children and families across the Russian Federation. Children retain their biological families or find new parents. They have happy emotionally rich childhood, obtain good education and professional training and are able to grow into mature, successful, independent adults.



Since 2004 VCF has been running its programs in 46 regions of the Russian Federation





✓ More than 15000 orphan children became beneficiaries of our organization, 5000 substitute families received psycho-pedagogical consultations, 2600 specialists upgraded their professional skills. There were more than 310 orphanages that received assistance via VCF.







PROGRAM AREAS









CHILD ABANDONMENT PREVENTION

VCF is implementing projects aimed at abandonment and orphanhood prevention, reduction of the number of children who lose opportunity to grow in their biological families.

CHILDREN VILLAGES

With aim to provide orphan kids with family-like settings VCF is building a "Victoria Children Village" in the south of Russia in Krasnodarskiy Kray.

FAMILY PLACEMENT OF ORPHANS AND ABANDONED CHILDREN

VCF supports all forms of family placement for orphaned and abandoned children working in cooperation with public agencies and local communities.

SOCIAL AND LIFE SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

VCF implements projects which provide children with key competencies that help to become successful and independent adults.

ADVANCING VOLUNTEERISM AND PARENTAL CARE

VCF advances volunteerism to be valued in society, improves the quality of voluntary work and increases the number of people who are ready to provide support to abandoned and disadvantaged children.



We want every child to live and grow up in a loving family, first and foremost in their own family. That is why we are engaged in the prevention of family problems, which may result in child orphanage.

The "Close Ones" program aims at reducing the risk of children's being taken away from the family and at preventing backwardness.

We help parents and children stay together, providing them with social and psychological support, training children in developing groups.

The "Family School" program aims at helping children to be adopted by a family and at building up foster parents.

We help children without parents to find a new family. We arrange schools for foster families, we are engaged in children's psychological adjustment. Since 2012 our Foundation has been an authorized organization for training those who wish to adopt a child.

The "Family Circle" program aims at psychological and pedagogical support for adopted children and at foster families support.

It is important that adopted children feel needed and loved, and that foster parents feel the joy of parenthood.

The program deals with health promotion of adolescent orphans.
The aim is to provide children with the knowledge of healthy living and To prevent them from bad habits such as smoking or alcohol abuse.
We engage adolescent children in sport activities.
